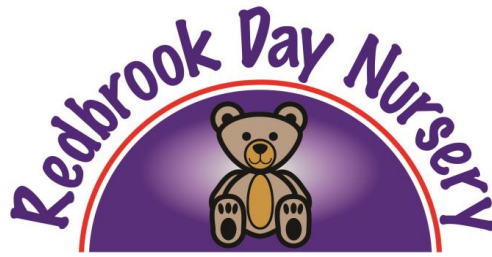

### About us:

Welcome to Redbrook Day Nursery, we provide high standards of care for babies and children from 0 to 12 years of age.

The nursery was established in 2004 and is conveniently placed in a peaceful and private location on Wrexham Industrial Estate. We are registered with the Care Social Services Inspectorates for Wales for up to 73 children including 12 babies.

Our facilities comprise of 6 main areas; Baby Room, Toddler room, Pre-school Room, Role-play Room, Holiday Club room and a dining area which can also be used for "messy play". We also have a kitchen where we freshly prepare all the children's meals.

We have a large enclosed safe outdoor play area .

The benefits we are able to offer parents and children at Redbrook include:

- Purpose built safe and secure environment.
  - Qualified and dedicated staff.
    - CCTV in all rooms.
  - Indoor and outdoor play areas.
    - Self contained baby room.
  - School pick and home pick up available.

## **Staff**

Our staff are childcare qualified (level 2-7) and trained at a high standard. All staff attend regular training courses and are given the opportunity to further their qualifications. All staff have First Aid and Safeguard training.

The staff/child ratios within which we work are:

- 0-2 years 1:3
- 2-3 years 1:4
- 3 years + 1:8

## **Routines**

All children in our care are treated individually and we follow parent's wishes at all times. Before a child/baby joins the nursery we discuss with parents the routine they wish us to follow, this helps the child to settle into nursery with more confidence and enables the staff to get to know the child and understand their needs more fully.

There are some set routines in which we work towards i.e. group story time, snack time.

## Our Menu

Most of our fruit, vegetables and meat are supplied fresh weekly from Bellis farm. This gives the children the right nutrition needed when having a busy and fun day. Our menu is checked by the health dietician at Wrexham Maelor hospital to ensure that the children are getting the right meals a day. Throughout the day the children are provided with breakfast, a morning snack, hot dinner and pudding and also a light tea.



## Activities

Activities are planned by staff to meet each child's individual developmental needs. Guidance from 'Birth to three matters' is taken into consideration when planning activities. We also ensure that children are working towards the Early Years Foundation curriculum as set out by the Welsh Assembly Government. Activities are varied and staff always join in and interact with the children. Activity planning is on display in each of the rooms for parents to view.



## Our Environment

### Baby Room (0-1.5 years)



Our baby room is very bright and spacious, and well equipped to provide comfort and stimulation to all babies in our care. Each babies individual needs are met at all times to ensure this we work very closely with parents, following their routine to ensure continuity between nursery and home. We provide the babies with freshly cooked meals taking into consideration each babies stage of weaning, all food is freshly prepared on the premises.

The babies have access to our out-door area so they can enjoy the fresh air, the nursery provides prams/pushchairs for young babies. Babies also have a separate sleep room where they can enjoy a softly decorated room which is away from the hustle and bustle of the older children

All activities are planned depending on age and stage of development taking guidance from "Birth to three matters". Babies also get involved with the themes and topics that are going on throughout the nursery.

## Toddler Room (1.5 years-2.5 years)



The toddler room provides a lively and stimulating environment for children as they grow more confident and increasingly mobile.

The emphasis in the toddler room is "active fun" as the children continue to explore the world around them, develop their communication skills and build on the skills they have already developed in the baby room.

The toddler room is split into the following areas:

- Sand and water area
  - Messy area
- Construction area
- Quiet area
- Mark making area

Toddler's have access to our outside area at all times to enable them to learn about the environment and ever changing weather, as well as enjoying the fresh air.

All activities are planned depending on age and stage of development, and also incorporating the themes and topics of the nursery.

## Preschool Room (2.5 years-4 years)



Pre-school room is very busy and action packed, providing the children with a wealth of experience, helping to promote independence and helping prepare them for school.

Pre-school have access to our outdoor area at all times making the most of the fresh air and getting to know the wildlife and environment.

The pre-school room consists of the following areas:

- Sand and water area
- Construction area
- Mark making/ Cutting and sticking area
  - Role play area
  - Messy area
  - Playdough area
  - Sensory Room
  - Music Area
  - Small World



All activities are planned depending on age and stage of development, pre-school work towards Birth to three and the Foundation Phase.

Our role play house provides the children with the opportunity to develop their social skills in a warm and bright environment.

### **Tennis Lessons**

Once a week Jo from Wrexham Tennis Club provides fantastic tennis lessons for all the preschool children (3 years). This includes learning lots of physical hand eye co-ordination techniques, fun and exciting ball games and learning how to participate in team games and much more. There is £1 extra charge for this lesson every week and the rest is paid by the nursery.

### **Three year olds Early Years Funded sessions**

Since January 2016 the preschool children can now receive 10 hours a week free childcare funding from the Welsh Assembly Government. This is for children who have birthdays that fall between the terms of September-April. Please speak to a member of staff for more information on how to apply for this funding.



## Holiday Club



During the school holidays the dining room is used by our holiday club children for messy activities, they also have their own computer room. Our aim at Redbrook is to provide the children with as much fun as possible!! They have their own toys and equipment suited to their age and abilities as well as having the opportunity to use all the nursery equipment. We plan lots of exciting trips and outings in our nursery vehicle

## Dining room

All children join together for meal times in our dining room. We have age appropriate chairs and tables for each age group



## Our Garden/Outdoor

We have a very large enclosed garden which is suitable for all age's, this is split up into different areas. One area has soft safety flooring especially design for the younger children and babies.

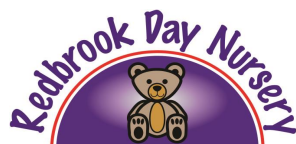
We have a wide range of outdoor equipment for the children to play with.

**Holidays and illness:** The nursery is closed Bank holidays NO fees are charged, 100% discount given for one week of the child's days they attend for example a child that attends 5 days will get 5 days holiday and a child that attends one day a week will get 1 day's holiday etc. Please inform the manager a month in advance. If children are absent for any other reason, including illness normal fees apply.

**Discounts:** 10-20% discount is offered for siblings and deducted from fees if both attend the same number of sessions.

**Payments:** Fees are payable in advance by the first day of every month, late payments will incur an extra charge. BACS, cash, card and ALL child care vouchers are accepted.
